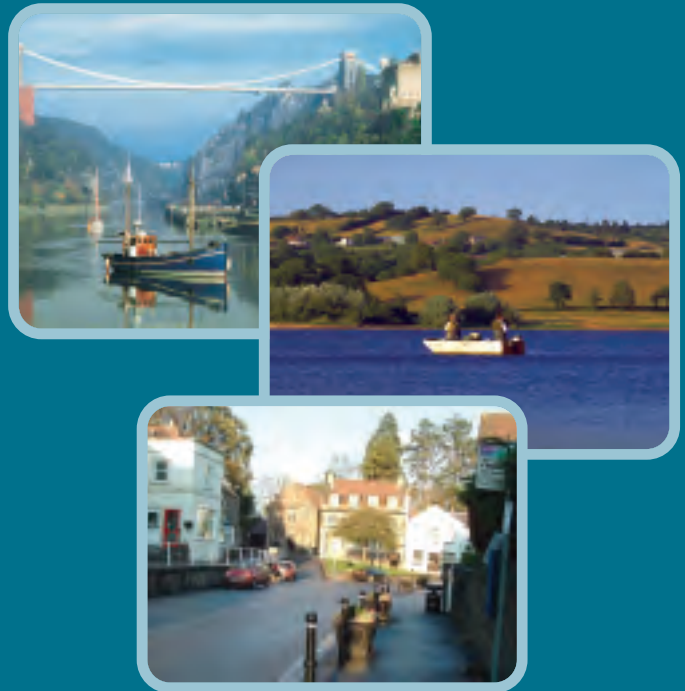

- NS** - Does not run Saturdays
