

CLERKS REPORT FOR 18 AUGUST 2010 MEETING

1. Highways

The condition of the pavement area on Bristol Road where Mr Saunders had fallen down has been reported to BANES Highways Department. As far as I am aware nothing has been done as yet and have chased BANES for an update.

2. Library Service

3. Stoke Inn

The Enforcement Officer has been informed that there might be someone living in the Caravan in the Stoke Inn Car Park. He has been asked him to get back to us with his findings.

5. Swings – Play Area

Following Vandalism of the cradle swing, this has now been replaced and BANES have confirmed they are happy with the situation and will check the seat when they carry out their next inspection.

6. Bollards at the Ford, Pilgrims Way

I have reported to BANES that one of the bollards needs re-securing back into place and also could they return the one they took away some months ago – I have been informed that Highways will look into this and report back to me.
