- 059/20-21 **Westaway Land – Tree Planting Scheme & Solar Farm – Agenda items 7 & 10**
Agreed that a feasibility study should be carried out within the next 2 to 3 months. There was room for both Tree Planting and a Solar Farm. Grants are available – This to be investigated.
